Windows 98. NT. XP. and 2000 Platform

Acrobat Reader 8.0 Installation

Acrobat Reader 8.0 can be installed from this CD-ROM. The install program is located in:

reader8\setup.exe

Starting the Conference Proceedings on CD-ROM (Windows 95, 98, NT, XP or 2000)

Load the CD-ROM into your computer. The “Title” screen will be launched automatically. Or you may launch the Adobe Acrobat Reader program, after it has been installed, and open the “Title.pdf” file in the root directory.

Unix Platform

Acrobat Reader Installation

To install Acrobat Reader, you must go to: www.adobe.com and download the latest version.

Macintosh Platform

Acrobat Reader 8.0 Installation

To install Acrobat Reader 8 (with the Search Plugin), you must go to: www.adobe.com and perform an online (web-based) installation.

Starting the Conference Proceedings on CD-ROM (Macintosh)

Load the CD-ROM into your computer. The “Title” screen will be launched automatically. If the CD-ROM “Title” screen does not launch automatically,

1. Double-click on the CP icon.
2. Double-click on the Title.pdf icon.

Using This CD-ROM

Start the CD-ROM according to the installation instructions for the platform you are using. From the "Title" screen, click on one of the following buttons:

- Table of Contents
- Copyright Page
- Search
- Help

Selecting the **Table of Contents** will link to a listing of the articles.

Selecting the **Copyright Page** will link to copyright information.

Selecting the **Search** will launch the search dialog box.

Selecting the **Help** will link to a detailed set of instructions for using the CD-ROM. Reading this file is highly recommended.

To access information through a **full-text search**:

- Click on the search button.
- Type a word or phrase in the dialog box. Search results will yield articles with that word or phrase in the full text.
- Enter a word or phrase in the title field. Search results will yield articles with that word or phrase in the title.
- Enter a name in the author field. Search results will yield articles with that name in the author list.
