1. A stipend of \$40,000 annually plus tuition and fees for up to four years of graduate study and research.
2. An opportunity to engage with a Texas A&M University faculty member who is an elected member of the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering and Medicine or a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
