My name is Mandie Greiwe, and I am the Director of the Disability Resource Center here at Purdue.

I am reaching out, as I was informed that you are a graduate student who has been involved in the Peer Mentor Program within the DRC previously, and we are excited to announce that we have a unique graduate student opportunity for the 24-25 school year.

The Graduate Peer Mentor Leader position will serve as the primary person responsible for overseeing and implementing the PMP program for this school year. They will help with training, workshops, and activities throughout the school year, and will be the primary contact for all mentors and senior mentors.

This graduate assistantship position is paid, with a base annual salary of \$28000 for the fiscal year, paid biweekly.
