

## Community Engaged Internship with Chicago Wilderness Alliance and Illinois-Indiana Sea Grant

Application deadline: April 19, 2024

Illinois-Indiana Sea Grant (IISG), in cooperation with <u>Chicago Wilderness Alliance</u> (Alliance), is offering a Community Engaged Internship (CEI) opportunity to support the Alliance with Congress 2024, an event where partners can reaffirm their commitment to a shared Green Vision.

Working with the Alliance coordinator, program assistant, and communications consultant, the intern will perform data entry, manage digital assets, create social media posts (both writing and graphic design), assist with meetings, and perform other business tasks. The intern might also support the Alliance's Green Vision Initiatives by creating newsletter, website, or social media content.

For eligibility, students must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree at a 2- or 4-year college or university at the time of application. IISG and the Alliance encourage applicants from groups that are historically underrepresented in the sciences, including African-American, American Indian or Alaska Native, Hispanic and Latino/a/x, female, first-generation college students, veterans, LGBTQ+, and students with disabilities. The program is also open to students who have experienced and worked to overcome educational or economic disadvantages, and/or who have personal or family circumstances that may complicate their career paths.

The intern will be paid \$17.00 per hour for 37.5 hours per week for eight weeks. Start and end dates are flexible depending on the student's academic schedule, however, the position will start no later than June 3, 2024.
