The SDF program is now accepting applications from PhD-level scientists and Masters of Engineering from all scientific disciplines, including life sciences, social sciences, mathematics, engineering, public health, and medicine. The inaugural group of Fellows will serve in USAID/Washington for two years, from October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2026, with an optional third year.
