As a Hydrologist within the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Water Science Center, some of the specific duties would include:

- Collecting, processing, and compilation of data to be used in computations of water quantity and quality including data from continuous monitors and discrete water quality samples.

- Working as part of an interdisciplinary team to collect data to meet research and project goals.
- Contributing to investigative projects which includes evaluation of data from various sources, and contributing to interpretive studies and hydrologic projects.
- Computing, analyzing, interpreting, and developing presentations of hydrologic, water quality and other data using computerized statistical, geographic information system, and other programs.
- Assisting in the writing of interpretive reports of hydrologic, or water quality related studies.

Applicants should be strong communicators, be willing to work in all weather conditions, and be able to both work independently and as part of a team.
