# LETTER TO POTENTIAL SPONSOR

Dear Company Representative,

It is with great excitement that the Purdue Student Chapter of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers announces the official start of our activities for the 2023-2024 school year; we hope this letter finds you well!

The past couple of years have represented a period of immense growth for our organization – we have massively expanded (and continue to expand) our range of student programming with the goal of connecting companies (like yours!) to exceptional chemical engineering students at Purdue. In August 2022, we started a Diversity & Inclusion committee to allow students to hear from corporate sponsors how DEI tenants are attained across the industry. In September 2022, we moved our ever-popular IR Banquet back in person and were able to provide **over 50 students with one-on-one meeting time with our corporate sponsors** just before Purdue's Industrial Roundtable career fair.

The COVID-19 pandemic provided us with a reminder that even in uncertain times, Purdue AIChE members are innovative and can develop new ways to interface with industry representatives. Our Alumni Mentorship Program was founded in Fall 2020 and has **virtually connected over 40 unique students with over 30 unique industry alumni.** The one-on-one coaching provides students with assistance in resume building and interview preparation as well as post-graduation advice such as managing finances and finding career fulfillment. On top of this new program, our organization planned **over 10 industry-focused events** in the last year, ranging from plant tours to engaging information sessions to problem-solving events, all bringing representatives like you in direct contact with students.

We strongly encourage you to explore our website and social media (page 4) or speak with us to see how your generous gifts have been used in the past and will be used in the future. With restrictions being lifted, we are excited that many of our events will be returning in-person, such as the 2023 IR Banquet and the 2023 IR Mega Prep Night.




## GENDER DEMOGRAPHICS






Save the Date: Sunday, September 10th, 2023.





Scheduled, **in-person**, the weekend before Purdue's Industrial Roundtable, which attracts nearly **10,000 students** 





The banquet consists of **6**, **15-minute rotations** in which company reps and students engage in **1:1 conversation**.

At the end, there will be time for companies to have more conversations with students, allowing for a more relaxed conversational atmosphere



Every September, Purdue Engineering Student Council (PESC) plans the Industrial Roundtable (IR). This two-day job fair attracts over 400 companies and over 10,000 students from Purdue University, making it one of the largest student-run job fairs in the nation. To help companies and chemical engineering students engage in meaningful, individual interactions before the fair even begins, Purdue AIChE hosts an annual IR Banquet the weekend before the career fair — this gives students the opportunity to make first impressions with companies and for companies to have first access to top-tier chemical engineering students. This is a business-professional event with a sit-down, catered dinner. This year, the banquet will be hosted in the Purdue Memorial Union North Ballroom. This will take place on Sunday, September 10th at 6:00 pm.

Each company is permanently seated at a table, as students rotate to different tables every 15 minutes. Because there are typically six rotations, each company will be guaranteed to personally meet with at least 24 students. We strive to have a 1:1 ratio of students to company representatives, meaning each table seats 4 students and 4 company representatives. Our goal is to make sure companies are seated with students interested in them and who are within their desired demographics.

The company cost for attending this event is **\$450** if purchased independently of a tiered sponsorship. For first-time company attendees, the cost is a special introductory price of only **\$300**.
