The Research Symposium Series is a department-sponsored forum for graduate students and advanced-level undergraduates to present their research to a general audience. The Research Symposium Series is designed to facilitate student-faculty discussions of research, provide opportunities for students to develop their technical presentation skills, and promote the research activities of the department. Free pizza will be provided at each session. The best graduate student presentations will be awarded: \$500 for first place, \$300 for second, \$200 for third. \$150 will be awarded to the best undergraduate presentation. In addition, abstracts will be also judged for clarity and content. The author of the best abstract will receive \$150.*
