The *Research Symposium Series* is designed to facilitate student-faculty discussions of research, provide opportunities for students to develop their technical presentation skills, and promote the research activities of the department. **Free pizza will be provided at each seminar.** The best graduate student presentations will be awarded: **\$500** for first place, **\$300** for second, **\$200** for third. **\$150 will be awarded to the best undergraduate presentation.** In addition, abstracts will be also judged for clarity and content. **The author of the best abstract will receive \$150.***
