The student may seek outside assistance for editorial purposes only, e.g. the Purdue writing lab or review by peers (not committee members). **The general concept laid out in the report should not simply be an incremental improvement over a past MS thesis, dissertations of other lab members, or grant proposals written by the advisor.**
