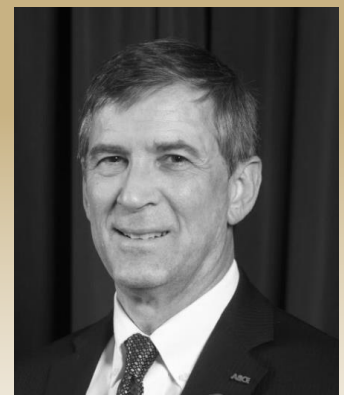
*Essential Lessons from the Great Builders*
