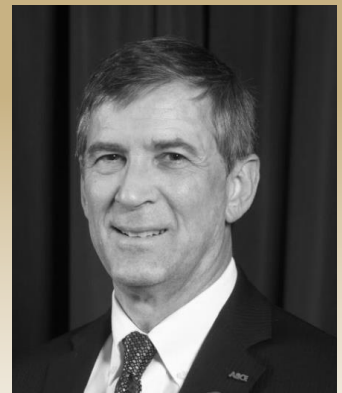
Essential Lessons from the Great Builders
