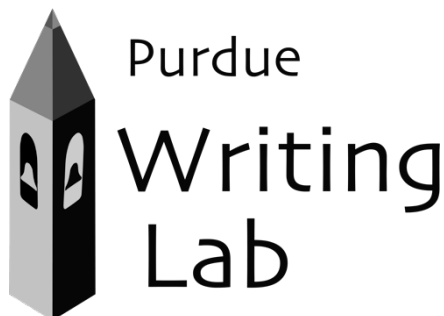




Graduate Writers' Room
