
## Exploring France's Burgundy Region May 12-19, 2017

Academic Program – The course is focused on understanding the culture of the Burgundy region of France. The regional economy is strongly rooted in traditional industries, such as wine, agriculture, and tourism, and it also boasts a significant presence in other types of industry such as fashion and technology. We will visit companies in this region to talk with their leadership about how they accomplish their goals.

The one credit course also provides opportunities to experience the French culture. Excursions include an architectural tour of Lyon, visits to local historical sites, wine tastings, and a cooking class on traditional French cuisine. Along the way, students will learn both about the French people and themselves. An optional visit to Paris is available at the end of the program.

**Accommodations** – Students will stay in a double or triple occupancy hotel suite with fellow students. Many meals will be provided. Transportation to and from the airport will be provided as well as to/from included activities. **Estimated Program Costs and** – The 2017 program fee is ~\$2500 plus airfare. The program fee includes tuition for the one credit course, housing, excursions, ground transportation to and from the airport and to all included excursions, guided tours, and most meals. The fee also includes a mandatory \$350 study abroad fee and insurance.

**Scholarships** - Most students qualify for a \$1000 scholarship through the Study Abroad Office.

**Program Dates** – Arrival in Lyon, France Friday, May 12, 2017 with departure on Friday, May 19, 2017. Students may elect to return to the US through Paris for a small extra fee.
