The Presidential Seminar develops leadership skills and involves students in a practicum of the negotiations of modern democracy and global relations. These issues are framed by a focus on World War I, the massive effect of which on modern history can now be seen in full perspective at its 100th anniversary. How did a "civilized" world blunder into this disaster? What lessons were learned about the modern role of political leadership and nation-building? What continue to be the consequences of the war, and what events and figures of our present day are reminiscent of those a

hundred years ago? In an active classroom setting with a focus on leadership and teambuilding, students will examine these questions and more about "The War to End All Wars," but didn't.
