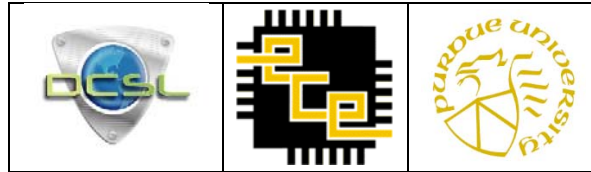


Paid Undergraduate Position in Research Web Development

We are seeking an undergraduate student capable of designing and maintaining a responsive web page for our research group, the Dependable Computing Systems Lab (DCSL). The web site was professionally designed a few years ago and so the baseline is reasonable. Job duties will include adding some new features, meant to make the site more interactive and visual. There will be some back-end development also, for providing access to version-controlled software and data repositories. The student must be highly motivated and responsible enough to make web page updates on a timely basis.

Necessary knowledge/skills: Wordpress, Javascript, HTML, CSS, Ajax, Photoshop.

Desired knowledge/skills: Understanding of REST/SOAP APIs, Git version control system.

Time commitment: 10 hours/week on an average.

Pay: Starting at \$12/hour, going up based on current knowledge/skills and with time on the job.

The interested student is asked to submit an inquiry over email to Prof. Saurabh Bagchi and Dr. Paul Wood with the following items of information. Use as email subject “DCSL web development application”.

- 1) Department, Year of undergraduate study
- 2) Proficiency level in the knowledge/skills mentioned above (high/medium/low)
- 3) Any prior experience developing web sites – point to URL if any and time period over which the development was done
- 4) Grades in software-oriented classes at Purdue along with when taken
- 5) CV in pdf format

We expect to finalize the hire within 2 weeks.
