(For alumni who received more than one ECE degree, eligibility is determined from the date of the most recent degree.)

GUIDELINES

- Nomination materials include: 1) a self-nomination form to be completed by you, and 2) a recommendation form to be completed by your supervisor or by a colleague who can evaluate the nature and impact of your design skills and potential.
- Both the self-nomination form and the recommendation form must be received for consideration. Incomplete award applications will not be evaluated.
- Nominations will be reviewed by a committee consisting of current members of ECE faculty and the Head of the School.
- The winner will be notified in **August 2017**
- The winner must return to campus to receive the award.
