

## J-1 Insurance Requirement

As a visitor, you are unable to purchase health insurance through Purdue University. You will need to purchase insurance prior to checking in at Purdue.

You may purchase insurance from a private agency in your home country or from a U.S. based company that provides insurance to international visitors.

Per the Department of State, you are required to have medical insurance in effect for yourself (J-1), your spouse and any dependents (J-2) for the duration of your program. Willful failure on your part to maintain the required insurance throughout your stay in the United States could result in the termination of your exchange program.

### Minimum insurance requirements as of 5/15/2015

Item	Minimum requirement
<b>Medical Benefits</b>	\$100,000
<b>Repatriation of remains</b>	\$25,000
<b>Medical evacuation</b>	\$50,000
<b>Deductible per accident or illness</b>	\$500 (not to exceed)
