- 2. There is a clear connection, but it is not well-explained
- 3: There is a clear connection, and it is well-explained
- 4. There is a clear connection, it is well-explained, it is well-written, and it demonstrates significant thought

## Question 3: Is there a clear benefit to the applicant's department? Is there a plan to share the learning?

- 0: There is no clear benefit to the applicant's department OR there is no plan to share the learning
