

Impact of Global Educational Experiences

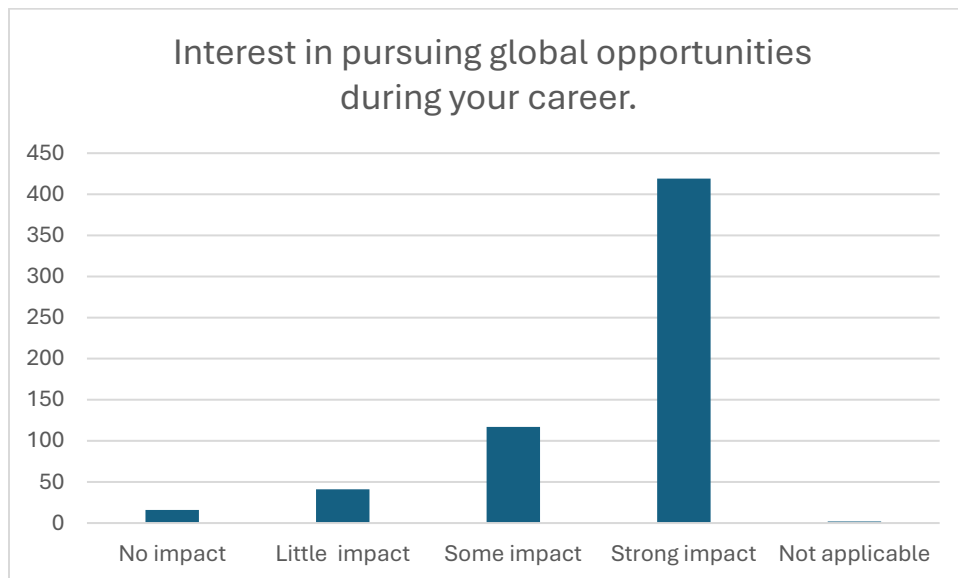
We were interested to know how participants perceived the career benefits of their undergraduate global experiences. In our survey, we asked participants to rate the impact their global educational program experience had on various aspects of their career.

Survey Question

How much impact has your global educational program experience had on the following aspects of your career?

Note: Respondents are asked to provide a response on a five-point Likert scale: No impact, Little impact, Some impact, Strong impact, Not applicable.

Results



The target group overwhelmingly believed their global educational program experience had an impact on their interest in global careers.



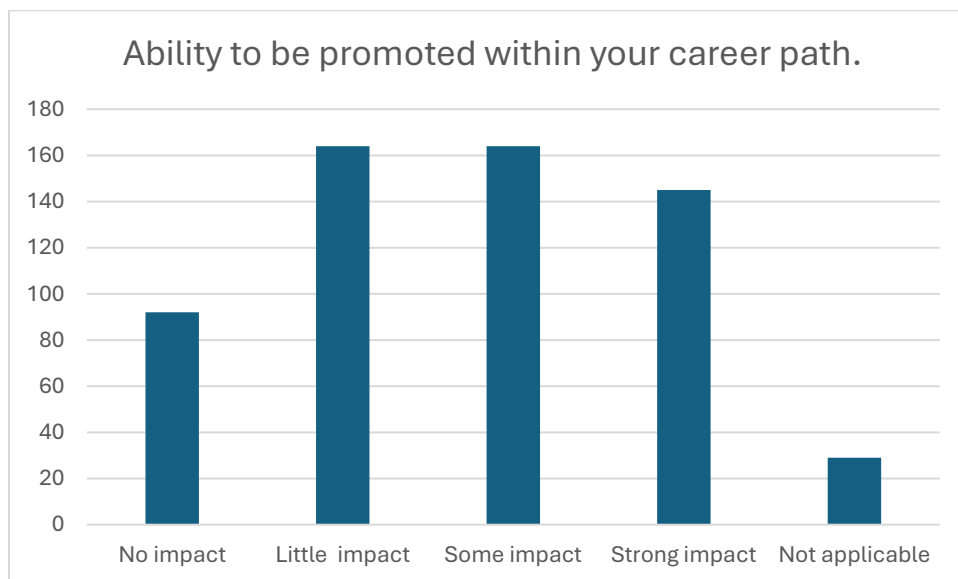
While not as strong as interest, there was a trend toward the global educational experience having had a strong impact on the ability to pursue global opportunities.



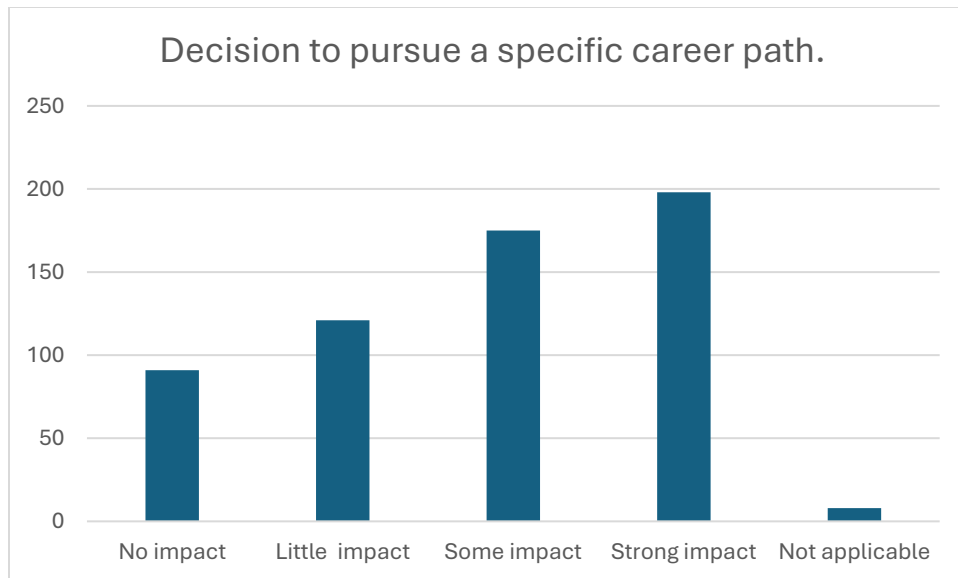
Participants believed their global educational experience positively impacted their ability to be a teammate on a professional team.



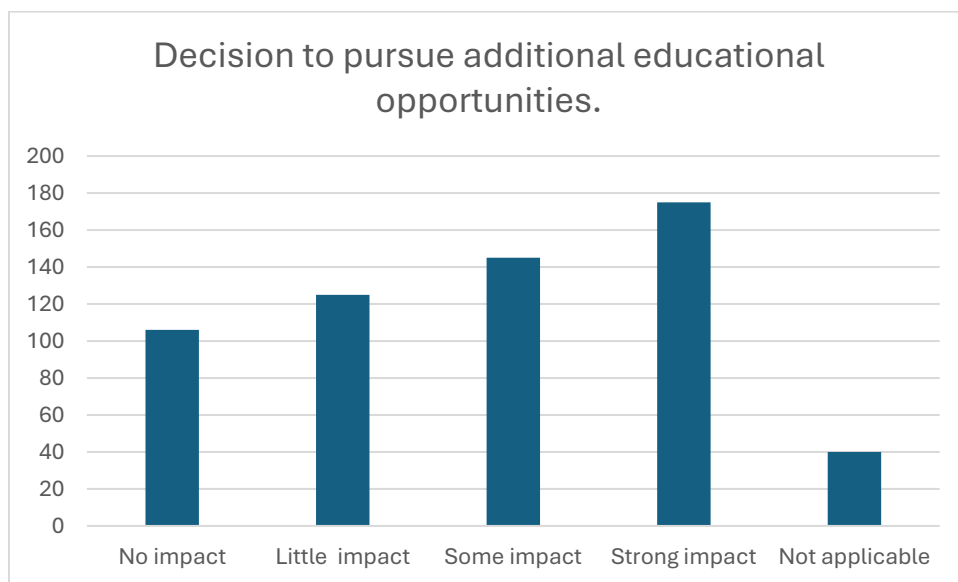
While a less strong trend than the ability to be a teammate, participants still felt their global educational experience impacted their ability to be a team leader.



Participants had mixed feelings about the impact of their global educational experience on their ability to be promoted.



While the results were mixed, more participants felt their global educational experience had “some” or a “strong” impact on their decision to pursue a specific career path than those who felt it had “little” or “no” impact.



Similar to the last question, participants were mixed about the impact of the global educational experience on their decision to pursue additional educational opportunities. However, the slight upward trend indicates that on average, participants felt the experience had some impact on their decision.
