
Global Experiences Summary

We were interested in the type, duration, and training involved in global educational experiences. We analyzed responses from the target group across a number of survey questions, below.


Survey question

How many different global educational programs did you participate in as an undergraduate student?




Most students participated in only one global educational program, though about 1/3 (30.9%) participated in two or more.

Please select the types of global educational programs you participated in during college (select all that apply):




Of the students surveyed, a majority went through Purdue University's GEARE program, followed by University of Rhode Island's International Engineering Program. Most of the students had an internship while abroad.

How much total time did you spend abroad for global educational programs?




A majority of students (44%) spent between 4 and 10 months abroad for their global educational program, with a relatively even split spending more or less time.

How many countries did you visit through global educational programs? Note: Please only count countries where there was an educational component (not just a weekend trip, for example).




Most students visited a single country during their undergraduate global educational experiences.
