How to copy a quiz from Blackboard to Brightspace

First, why do we want to do this? Answer: Looks like Blackboard quizzes which sample questions from question pools are not correctly transitioned to Brightspace. Luckily, it can be fixed. You need access to the quiz in Blackboard. The error that you can fix following the steps hereafter is:







Open the Brightspace course.




If you did not transition the course, create a new quiz first. Then, follow the steps, and ignore the deleting of the "empty" questions.


