






How to copy a quiz from Blackboard to Brightspace


First, why do we want to do this? Answer: Looks like Blackboard quizzes which sample questions from question pools are not correctly transitioned to Brightspace. Luckily, it can be fixed. You need access to the quiz in Blackboard. The error that you can fix following the steps hereafter is:

!Random Question Error!






1.	Go into the Blackboard course.	
2.		Click onto "Course Tools" on the left-hand navigation pane.
3.		Click onto "Tests, Surveys and Pools".
4.		Click onto "Tests".
5.		Find the quiz. A fast way to do so is to "Show All" at the bottom right of your screen (scroll down to get there).
6.		

7.		<p>Then, search (CTRL+F) for the name of the quiz you want to copy to Brightspace.</p> <p>When you found it, click onto the little arrow icon after its name and select "Export to Local Computer".</p>
8.	Now switch to Brightspace.	


9.	<p>Open the Brightspace course.</p> <p>If you transitioned the course, there is already a quiz called "Variable Names". You can use this one. We will delete the "empty" questions from the transition and import the downloaded questions from Blackboard.</p> <p>If you did not transition the course, create a new quiz first. Then, follow the steps, and ignore the deleting of the "empty" questions.</p>


10.1	First, we'll import the downloaded file from Blackboard as a Question Pool.	
10.2		Click onto "Course Tools" and select "Quizzes".
10.3		Switch to the "Question Library" tab.
10.4		Click onto "Import" and select "Upload a File".


<p>10.5</p>		<p>Drag-drop the downloaded file from Blackboard into the field.</p>
<p>10.6</p>		<p>Once complete (takes a few seconds), click "Import All".</p>
<p>10.7</p>		<p>Here are our question pools. Let's give them better names. You can do so by clicking the little arrow icon after its current name and selecting "Edit".</p>
<p>10.8</p>		<p>After clicking "Edit" change the name and hit "Save".</p>



