















How to do time extensions for quizzes and assignments

How to give a student time extensions and/or more attempts in a quiz:

Log into Brightspace and navigate to the quiz for which you would like to do a special accommodation :		
1.		Click onto the quiz for which you would like to give a student the special accommodation.
2.		Click onto "Quiz Setup".
3.		Switch to the "Restrictions" tab at the top.
4.		Scroll down until you see these options. Click "Add Users to Special Access".
5.		At the bottom you can select students for which you can change:
6.1		The start, due and end dates,
6.2		the number of attempts,
6.3		time constraints,
6.4	<p>Advanced Attempt Conditions</p> <p>To restrict access to attempts, enter a minimum and/or maximum percentage (0 - 100) that needs to be achieved on the previous attempt to qualify for another attempt.</p> <p>If the minimum and/or maximum percentage is left blank, it will not apply. If both are left blank, then there is no restriction.</p> <p>Attempt 2 - Min: <input type="text"/> % Max: <input type="text"/> % on Attempt 1</p> <p>Attempt 3 - Min: <input type="text"/> % Max: <input type="text"/> % on Attempt 2</p>	and the Advanced Attempt Conditions.

How to give a student time extensions for an assignment:

For assignments, the above procedure does not work, because the button for Special Access is missing. Here is how we can still get to this button:

Log into Brightspace and navigate to the assignment for which you would like to do a special accommodation :		
1.		Click onto "Course Tools" and select "Assignments".
2.		Click onto "Quiz Setup".
3.		Switch to the "Restrictions" tab at the top.
4.		Scroll down until you see these options. Click "Add Users to Special Access".
5.		At the bottom you can select students for which you can change:
6.		The start, due and end dates. (Not more like with the quiz, because those options do not apply to an assignment).
