
How to set Start Due and End Dates and what they mean

How to set the dates:

To set the dates for an assignment, click onto it, go to the "Activity Details" tab and click onto "Add dates and restrictions...":



What they mean:

Start Date: The assignment can be viewed and taken after this date. Before, only the title and its dates are visible to students.

Due Date: The assignment <u>should</u> be completed before this date. <u>It is possible to submit afterwards</u> ("late") if the end date is further in the future.

End Date: After this date the assignment cannot be viewed or taken anymore.

How to set visibility?

If you click onto the assignment, you see under the "Activity Details" tab the option:

"Visible" means it behaves as described below. "Hidden" (the only other option) means it is not visible to students.



Here a breakdown of all possible combinations:


All the dates are in the future. What happens?

The assignment shows up for the student, but the student cannot click onto it:





The Start Date is over, the others are not. What happens?
