Description:

Motorsports experimental classes offered at the senior level on a temporary basis to test the viability of offering the course on a permanent basis

Background:

As the Motorsports Program matures within the School of Mechanical Engineering there will be a need to offer experimental technical elective courses to students to test course viability. The rapid development of technology within the motorsports industry requires faculty with the support of the industry to educate and prepare students for the technical needs of the industry. Experimental courses provide faculty the ability to optimize topics, learning outcomes, and assessment mechanisms before requesting permanency of the course. The 49600 designation is consistent with a similar course utilized within the School of ME and the College of Engineering.
