Add additional major* to EEE 69800 and 69900

Reason: A number of ESE students are enrolling in research with EEE. Currently there is a "major" restriction on research credits to only EEE. We want to add IESE as another allowable major.

*major is the preferred term that the registrar uses when classifying graduate students. The term major has no academic bearing in the EEE program and associated documentation.
