Reason: The course will be used for industry projects in the Learning While Working (LWW) co-op, by which students will be gaining a yearlong work experience. During the three academic terms (Spring, Summer, Fall) students are expected to engage in industry projects which should be 2 or up to 3 credit/hr, faculty mentored activities which will be inspired by their technical work at the hosting company. The projects will be either covering different aspects each time or expanding the scope and complexity in the previously covered topic. Students are expected to be able to take this course in every semester while they are working.
