Re: Fast track EFD – Add distance delivery mode to AAE200/300; remove classroom delivery

Courses: AAE 200 Sophomore Seminar and AAE 300 Junior Seminar

Reasons:

Moving AAE 200 Sophomore seminar to distance learning enables all newly admitted AAE T2M students to take the course in their first semester when the information is most beneficial to their degree progression. Fall 2021 enrollment is currently 341, finding a room for this class size is difficult without conflicts.

Moving AAE 300 Junior seminar to distance learning enables students to take the class in their first semester of their junior year when the information is most beneficial to their degree progression. Fall 2021 enrollment is currently 268, finding a room for this class size is difficult without conflicts.
