Courses to be Expired:

- ABE 31000 - Thermodynamics Of Food And Biological Systems
- ABE 52500 - Irrigation Management And Design
- ABE 55500 - Biological And Food Processing Unit Operations
- ABE 55600 - Biological And Food Process Design

Reason:

ABE 31000 has not been taught in more than 4 years, there are no plans to teach it in the future, and it is no longer part of the Biological Engineering curriculum.

ABE 52500 has not been taught in more than 4 years, the primary instructor retired, and there are no plans to teach it in the future.

ABE 55500 and ABE 55600 have been replaced with ABE 55700 and ABE 55800 in current requirements.
