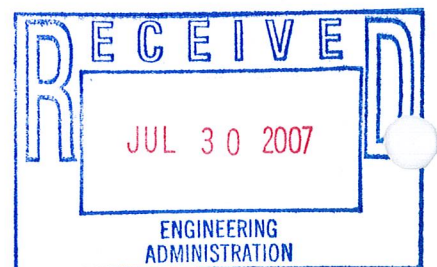

This internship experience is intended to complement the student's academic coursework and help prepare the student for a career as a practicing engineer. Program coordinated by school with cooperating employers. A written report is required. This course may be repeated but may not be taken in successive semesters
