Prerequisite: First semester sophomore standing or higher; only open to students in Civil Engineering. Authorized equivalent courses or consent of instructor may be used in satisfying course pre- and co-requisites.

Professional experience in Civil Engineering. This internship experience is intended to complement the student's academic coursework and help prepare the student for a career as a practicing engineer. Program coordinated by school with cooperating employers. A written report is required. This course may be repeated but may not be taken in successive semesters

CE 397 Undergraduate Professional Internship

Sem. 1, 2, and SS., Cr. 0

Prerequisite: First semester sophomore standing or above in Civil Engineering and consent of instructor.

Professional experience in Civil Engineering. This internship experience is intended to complement the student's academic coursework and help prepare the student for a career as a practicing engineer. Program coordinated by school with cooperating employers. A written report is required. This course may be repeated but may not be taken in successive semesters.
