The Faculty of the Davidson School of Chemical Engineering have approved the following changes. This action is now submitted to the Engineering Faculty with a recommendation for approval.

**Course:** CHE 20500 Chemical Engineering Calculations

**Current Requisite:** Pre-requisite: ENGR 13100, PHYS 17200, MA 16500  
Con-Current Requisite: CHM 11600

**Proposed Requisite:** Pre-requisite: ENGR 13100 **or equivalent**, PHYS 17200,  
**MA 16500 Minimum Grade of C-**  
Con-Current Requisite: CHM 11600

**Reason:** A change in requisites to include ENGR 13100 or equivalent will allow all students who complete the FYE Curriculum an opportunity to enroll in this course. Currently the listed requisite prevents a student who completed the an equivalent of this course (ENGR 16100, EPCS 11100 & 12100, or ENGR 17911) from enrolling. Also, to be transparent, and consistent with the Math Departments requirement of students to earn a minimum grade of a C- or higher to proceed to the next course in the math sequence.
