Restriction: Must be enrolled in the School of Biomedical Engineering (BME) with either Junior or Senior standing  
Term offered: Spring, Studio 4, Cr. 2  
Prerequisites: BME 29000 and BME 25600

**Reason:** The content and concepts taught in BME 25600 are a necessary prerequisite for success in this course. Skipping the natural progression of 200-level to 300-level BME courses has proven detrimental to students in this case.
