Re: Fast track EFD – AAE 25100 adding ENGR 130 and VIP 17912 as pre-requisite options and minimum grade requirement

Courses: AAE 25100 Introduction to Aerospace Design

(Undergraduate level ENGR 13200 **Minimum Grade of C-** or Undergraduate level ENGR 14200 **Minimum Grade of C-** or Undergraduate level ENGR 16200 **Minimum Grade of C-** or Undergraduate level ENGR 130 **Minimum Grade of C-** or Undergraduate level EPCS 12100 **Minimum Grade of C-** or Undergraduate level VIP 17912 **Minimum Grade of C-**) and Undergraduate level CGT 16300 **Minimum Grade of C-** [may be taken concurrently] and (Undergraduate level CS 15900 **Minimum Grade of C-** [may be taken concurrently] or Undergraduate level CS 17700 **Minimum Grade of C-** [may be taken concurrently] or Undergraduate level CS 18000 **Minimum Grade of C-** [may be taken concurrently])

Reasons: ENGR 130 and VIP 17912 both satisfy AAE25100 academic needs. Adding them to Banner will reduce the number of override requests in the workflow system. Additionally, updating ENRG/EPCS/VIP courses with a C- grade requirement to be consistent with the C- grade requirement for other FYE options.
