
FROM:

ME 500 Thermodynamics Sem. 2. Class 3, cr. 3 (el.). Prerequisite: ME 300.

TO:

ME 500 Advanced Thermodynamics Sem. 1. Class 3, cr. 3. (Offered in alternate years). Prerequisite: ME 300.

REASON: The title change for ME 500 is intended to reflect the more advanced nature of ME 500 in contrast to ME 200 Thermodynamics I and ME 300 Thermodynamics II. Also, the offering has changed to Fall semester in alternate years. The elective course designation "(el.)" will also be deleted because it is inconsistent with the rest of the Undergraduate Catalog.
