RE: ME 505 Course Description Changes

The Faculty of the School of Mechanical Engineering has approved the following change in course title effective Spring Semester 2001. This action is now submitted to the Engineering Faculty with a recommendation for approval.

FROM:

ME 505 Heat and Mass Transfer Sem. 1. Class 3, cr. 3 (el.). Prerequisite: ME 315.

TO:

ME 505 Intermediate Heat ~~and Mass~~ Transfer Sem. 1. Class 3, cr. 3. Prerequisite: ME 315.

REASON: The title change for ME 505 is intended to reflect the more advanced nature of ME 505 in contrast to ME 315 Heat and Mass Transfer. Also, since there is little emphasis on mass transfer in the course, the "and Mass" part of the title is not merited. The elective course designation "(el.)" will also be deleted because it is inconsistent with the rest of the Undergraduate Catalog.
