The Interdisciplinary Engineering team has approved the following new graduate course, which will be available online. This action is now submitted to the Engineering Faculty with a recommendation for approval.

Name: ENGR 699XX - Doctor of Engineering Research

Semesters offered: Fall, Spring and Summer – first offering, Spring 2025

Credits: 1.00 to 18.00 credits per semester; standard academic calendar

Pre-Requisites: None required.

Details: Designed for online engineering doctoral students to participate in a mentored research experience.

Course Title: Doctor of Engineering Research

Permission of instructor required. 1.000 TO 18.000 Credit hours per semester. May be repeated an unlimited number of times.

RATIONALE:

No existing research course through the College will work for an online doctoral program. Since the Doctor of Engineering program is being offered fully online and a minimum 30 credits per student are required for research, this Doctoral level research course is necessary to add. Research expectations will be determined by the instructor and student.
