Permission of instructor required.
Typically offered Fall Spring Summer. **Credits:** 1.00 to 3.00

Course Description:
Courses on topics of contemporary importance or special interest in nuclear engineering. Hours and credits to be arranged.

Reason: NUCL 69700 currently includes both individual research projects and selected topics courses. The School proposes to split these into two separate courses. NUCL 69700: “Selected Topics in Nuclear Engineering-II” will correspond only to the courses. The research projects will be moved to NUCL 69500, a new course.
