
RE: Changes in requisites to BME 49000 Professional Development and Design in Biomedical Engineering

The Faculty of the School of Biomedical Engineering has approved the following change in requisites to an existing course. This action is now submitted to the Engineering Faculty with a recommendation for fast-track approval.

Prerequisite: BME 39000

Reason: The two lab sections of the BME senior design sequence have recently been combined from BME 48800 + BME 48900 to the new BME 48901. Therefore, the Co-requisite requirement of BME 48800 is no longer valid for this class and must be removed. BME 49000 is now listed as a Concurrent Prerequisite on BME 48901.
