
Level: Undergraduate lower level

Reason: An undergraduate lower-level variable-credit, variable-titled-course is needed. This course may be used, but is not limited to the following examples:

- Supplemental Instruction to handle deficiencies; currently a supplemental CE 23100 Materials lab or a supplemental CE 27000 Structural Mechanics lab receives a 49700 course number.
- Study Abroad courses mapping to lower level course currently receives a CE 49700 or CE 59700 designation. Non-majors also receive CE 49700 for a civil engineering related study abroad course.
- Temporary number for a new lower-level course.
