1 to 6 total credits

NUCL 69000 Independent Study in Nuclear Engineering II

1 to 6 credits total credits

Permission of instructor required.

Independent research projects. Interested students seek a faculty instructor in their area of special interest and prepare a brief description of the independent project to be undertaken. May be taken for 1-6 credits in Fall, Spring, or Summer. May be repeated as many times as desired, but only maximum of 6 credits may be counted for the degree program requirement.

RATIONALE:

NUCL 69700 currently includes both independent research projects and selected topic courses. The School decided to split these into two separate courses; the independent research projects corresponding to NUCL 69000.
