The faculty of the School Civil Engineering has approved the deletion of the following course. This action is now submitted to the Engineering Faculty with a recommendation for approval.

CE 425 Construction Practice Project

Sem.1 and 2. Class 3, cr. 3

Prerequisite: CE 22100, CE 32100, and CEM 29100. Authorized equivalent courses or consent of instructor may be used in satisfying course pre- and co-requisites.

The capstone, senior design course for construction engineering and management majors. Working in teams in a realistic engineering practice environment, students use an actual construction project to accomplish open-ended project planning and systems design. Course covers construction project strategy, cost estimating and bidding, constructability analysis, project scheduling, contract conditions, project organization, site analysis and development, safety and quality management, and information systems design. Comprehensive written submittals and oral presentations require integration of knowledge gained in previous courses and in construction internships.

Reason: This course is the senior design course for the division of Construction Engineering and Management. No civil engineering students enroll in the course. In the future, this course will be offered with a CEM designator.
