

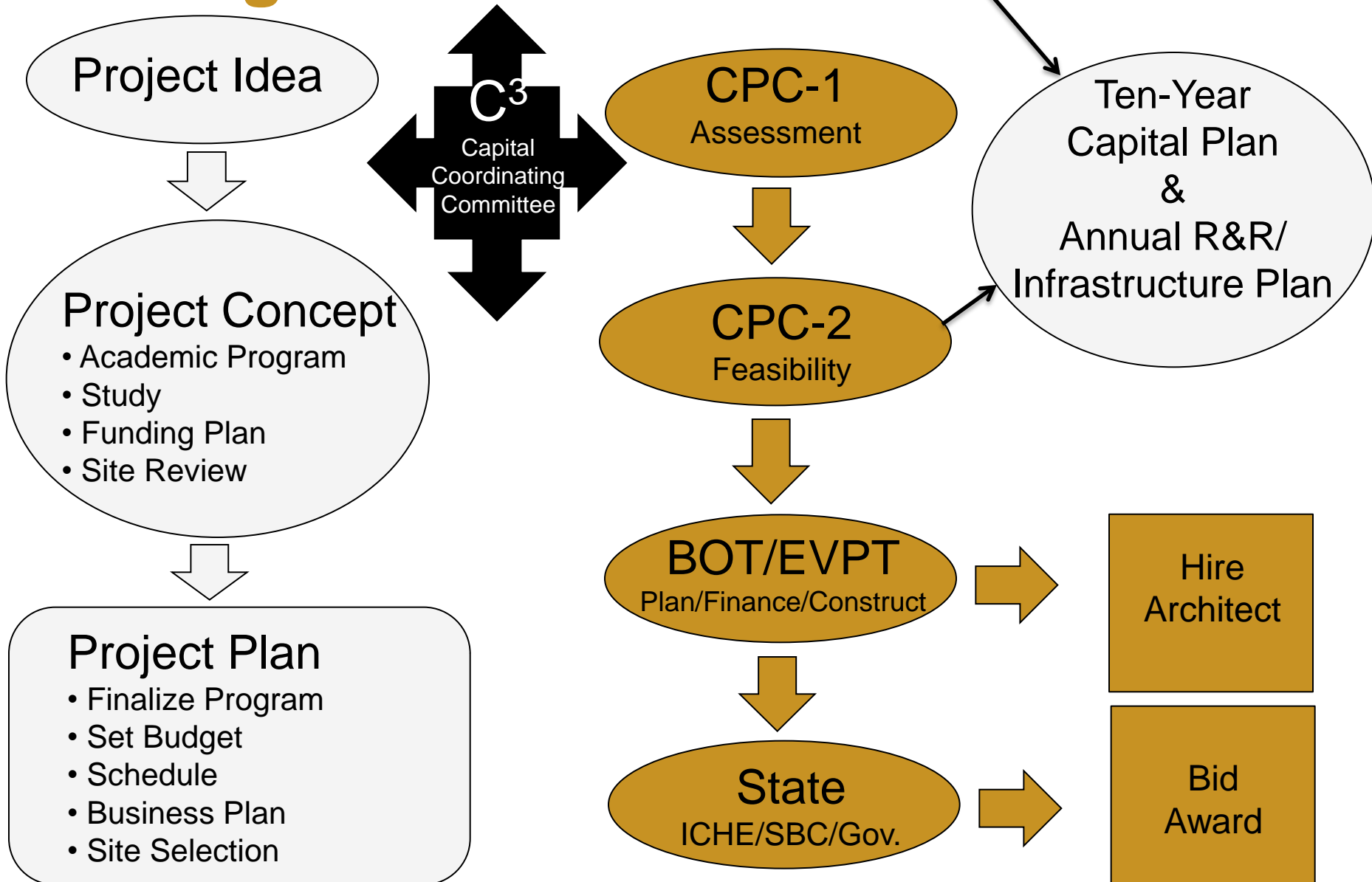
Capital Project Planning Process
