In case of injury to any individual in the labs at Purdue University, please take action according to the chart below. Even though Indiana is a Good Samaritan state and assistance provided in good faith is not subject to liability, please encourage professional medical treatment of injuries.

**Regardless of the incident, a *First Report of Injury* must be completed and submitted by a supervisor.**

### How to get there

- In the situation of a medical emergency (serious illness or injury), call 911 for transportation.
- If you can safely drive yourself, use a private vehicle to go to an approved medical provider.
- Your supervisor or another designated person may drive you to an approved medical provider using a private or University vehicle.
- If you or someone else drives a personal vehicle they assume liability to any damage to their vehicle or to any other vehicles if an accident occurs.
