ECE 397 and 398 are taken by our cooperative education (those who have taken ECE 394 or 395, the co-op work session courses) and internship students (those who have taken ECE 496I, the internship course). These courses will be incorporated into ECE 396, *Industrial Practice Seminar I*, which will be renamed Industrial Practice Seminar and will then be repeatable for credit (EFD 53-02 is being processed for these changes in ECE 396).
