The faculty of the Department of Engineering Education has approved the following new graduate ENE course. This action is now submitted to the Engineering Faculty with a recommendation for approval.

ENE 695 Advanced Topics in Engineering Education.

Sem. 1 and 2. SS. Cr. 1-3. Admission by consent of instructor. (May be repeated for credit.)

Description: Primarily designed for specialized topic areas for which there is no specific course, workshop, or individual study plan, but having enough student interest to justify the formalized teaching of an advanced course.

Reason: The Department of Engineering Education (ENE) was recently formed, and is now authorized by Purdue University and the Indiana Commission of Higher Education, to coordinate the education of M.S. and Ph.D. level students in this field. This addition is made to accommodate new course material of current interest to graduate students in the Department of Engineering Education and graduate students in other Departments, Schools, and Colleges with engineering education or related interests.

Recurring courses taught hereunder will ultimately become separate courses with their own formalized number and description.
