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Number of TA's that is given is the number of FTE's, so multiply by two for half-time TA's.

Heister's comment is that *"updated my running tally on the workload that our TAs see and the bars march ever higher.*

While i'll acknowledge that the recent use of graders complicates the story somewhat,

I still submit that the quality of the education we provide is inversely proportional to the height of these bars." (1 Sept. 2011)
