ON-LINE TRAINING

- Issues
 - Script
 - Registration
 - Tests

 - Costs • Fees
 - Access

LEGISLATIVE AUDIT BUREAU (LAB)

- o Perform audits annually, at a minimum
- Historically, concentrated on department testing
- o Recently, began looking at contractor testing
- ${\color{red} \circ}$ Look for:
 - Testing frequency according to specifications
 - · Correct incentive/disincentive payments
 - · Certified samplers and testers
- · If its in black and white, it better be done

REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATION

- o Certification is deemed to be a privilege. This privilege may be revoked if, in the opinion of the HTCP Advisory board,
- o an individual is thought to have knowingly committed acts that are detrimental to the integrity of the HTCP or
- o construction industry in general.
- Acts that could result in revocation of certification privileges:
- o _ Failure of a certificate holder to renew the certificate prior to the regular expiration.
- o _ Falsification of field or quality control test results and/or records.

REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATION

- Cheating on certification examinations.
- ${\color{gray} \circ}$ _ Submittal of false information on certification applications.
- o _ Termination of an individual due to job incompetence.
- o _ Criminal action by an individual while engaged in construction activities.
- Failure to follow specification prescribed sampling/testing methods.
- o _ Failure to pass a reexamination of written and practical skills.

REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATION

- _ Failure to pay HTCP certification course tuition fees.
- ${\color{blue} \circ}$ _ Falsification of HTCP certificates and/or ID cards
- Revocation of certification procedure: Any individual, firm, agency or contractor associated with the HTCP may report a flagrant deficiency by a certified technician. The first response must be a written letter to the director of the HTCP. The director of the HTCP will follow the current adopted revocation of certification policy.
