



NMDOT/FHWA HMA Pavement Operations Joint Process Review Charter

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Mission

The purpose of this review is to:

- Perform a review of the NMDOT's current HMA pavement placement operations on NMDOT construction projects.
- Ascertain the present degree of compliance with the requirements.
- Determine if the current pavement procedures adequately ensure quality and durability.





Mission

The purpose of this review is to:

- Ascertain which existing NMDOT pavement policies are effectively working to ensure quality.
- Determine if there are current practices that are counter productive to higher quality and recommend appropriate remedial action.
- Determine if there are new national policies or procedures which might improve quality.
- Determine the level of understanding of NMDOT employees.





Scope of Review

The Process Review Team will:

- Conduct a Process Review of at least two ongoing HMA paving projects.
- Determine if the current policies are promoting quality and durability.
- Determine if NMDOT employees are consistently complying and enforcing contract procedures.
- Determine if the contractor is following the contract requirements.
- Compare findings with other DOTs.





Process Review Goals / Vision

- Improve pavement quality and durability.
- Improve public perception of NMDOT roadways.
- Increase level of training and experience for all NMDOT construction staff.
- Ensure construction project personnel have the ability to recognize non-compliance of specification and policies.
- Determine if there are established innovative measures to improve quality.
- Obtain NMDOT management endorsement of Plan and ensure its implementation.





Process Review Plan

- Complete Process Review Charter.
- Conduct project construction field reviews.
- Tabulate findings to determine non-compliance.
- Formulate report and develop implementation plan.
- Get sponsor concurrence of recommendations.
- Present Final Report.
- Ensure NMDOT implements approved recommendations.
